Cystinosis is a rare, inherited, metabolic disease that is characterized by the abnormal accumulation of the amino acid cystine in each of the body's cells. Build-up of cystine in the cells eventually destroys all major organs of the body including the kidneys, liver, eyes, muscles, bone marrow, thyroid and brain. Medication is available to control some of the symptoms of this terrible disease, but cystinosis remains incurable.
